

Abilene Supply List

Horse with properly trimmed / shod hooves. Do not wait until the last minute or you could have a lame horse from trimming too close or a hot nail.

Horse that is properly groomed.

Original current Coggins report. Must be less than 12 months old.

Horse feed – enough for all days.

Hay bag and fresh hay.

Buckets for feed and water with chains to hang them. Bring 2 water buckets if your horse is a big drinker. The climate is very hot and dry and the horses drink a lot of water.

Box fan.

Electrical cord at least 50 feet for fan. Bring a multi plug if you have one.

Fly repellent. Fly mask by choice.

Bungee cords to hold everything.

Duct tape – always need it for something.

Horse medical bag – Bute, vet wrap, liniment. . .

Gatorade / cool aid for horses that will not drink water away from home.

Grooming supplies for bathing your horse – shampoo, brushes, combs, water hose, and clippers if you have them. Sharpen your clipper blades before you get to Abilene.

Manure rack and cart to haul stuff out of stall everyday. Stall must be completely emptied when leaving Abilene.

Shavings – at least 2 bags. They sell in Abilene at the gate but are more expensive than here.

Costumes for fast and precision drills. Precision drill is black pants, white tuxedo shirt, black hat with stamped string, black belt and snoods for the girl's hair. Clothing must be clean, starched and ironed. Boots must be cleaned and polished. Hats cleaned and reshaped if necessary. Do not forget your BELTS!! They need to be simple and western type. No loud silver decorations with the huge conchos.

Clean your drill tack. Make sure you have all accessories for your costumes.

Colored practice Tee-Shirts. You are required to wear them at team practice in the arena.

Please turn in your cell phone number for all members going for a current travel list. Don't turn in mom's phone if dad is coming. Turn in the child's cell number if they have one. We don't always need mom or dad.
